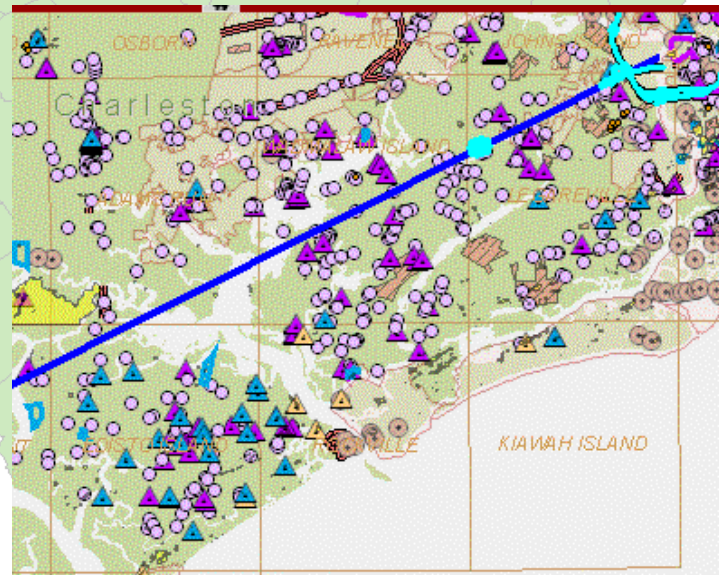
Results from searches include information about each resource.
